**“Contemporary Pediatric Dental Practice Models:
Economic, Social Impact, and Patient Care Outcomes”**

Course Description

This one-day course is designed to provide dental practitioners with an update of contemporary practice delivery models for the care of the pediatric population. Six different practice models will be described with regard to their structure, processes, and outcomes. In addition, the discussion of the practice models will describe the economic, social impact, and patient care outcomes, which the participants will be able to compare and contrast. Finally, the participants will be provided information about the current and future models for reimbursement for pediatric oral health care.

This course is taught in lecture format, followed by a panel discussion with all of the course speakers. The course is designed to impart the knowledge and confidence for delivering pediatric dental services with the greatest impact to benefit the care of children.

Dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, dental residents, dental students, dental hygiene students, dental assisting students

At the conclusion of the course, the participants will:

- Understand and apply the concepts of multiple practice delivery models, as listed below:
 - Solo practice with a pediatric dentist
 - Group practice with one location, exclusively with pediatric dentists
 - Group practice with one location and multiple general dentists, pediatric dentists, and other dental specialists
 - Dental Service Organization (DSO) model with one location, pediatric dentists and orthodontists
 - Group practice with multiple locations, multiple dentists, and multiple dental specialists in an urban environment
 - Federally Qualified Health Center model, with multiple locations, multiple dentists, and inter-professional practice with physicians
- Understand and apply the current and future models for reimbursement for pediatric oral health care, from the perspective of the dental insurance industry.
